

Lincom Group / Powerscreen® Screening & Crushing Invade South Australia

In recent times a number of new Powerscreen® Screening & Crushing systems have been supplied to customers in South Australia by Lincom Pacific Equipment Pty Ltd (part of the Lincom Group). Below, two such systems are outlined: -

Kanmantoo Bluestone

Bernard Clifford established Kanmantoo Bluestone in 1977 and they have been producing authentic bluestone building products since then, sending them Australia wide. The stone is sorted, picked, split, sized, stacked etc all by hand! They also cut dimension Bluestone & Veneers. The site has been a source of stone for local fences and farmhouse since the late nineteenth century. Three to four years ago Bernard decided it was time to expand and to look at supplying crushed aggregates, railway ballast, road bases and rubbles. He hired in contractors to produce these materials for him and even dry hired some equipment to fill short falls in the ability of the outside contractors to get on site and to produce the required specifications. After going through this process

for a couple of years Bernard decided to ensure that his products were cost effective and to control all aspects of the crushing process and the specifications of the products produced the only way to go was to purchase his own equipment.

Bernard says “having looked at numerous crushing plants around Australia, I was impressed with the Powerscreen® Crushing and Screening equipment from the Lincom Group and with regular interaction with their Sales Manager it became apparent that this was my preference. I spoke to a number of operators and it was clear that I needed machines that could produce both a high quantity and quality of material”

For the first part of the plant and due to the nature of the rock and the way that it fractures it was decided that an impact crusher will be required to produce the railway ballast. So a Powerscreen® Pegson 1412 impact crusher was used to primary crush the raw product, which was then feed to a Powerscreen® Chieftain 2100X with a 20' x 5' three deck screen box, the oversize was re-circulated back to the Impactor. The railway ballast was stockpiled out one side, sand / dust was taken out the back and the bottom deck oversize material was fed to a vertical shaft Impactor (VSI) to shape the material which was then fed to another



Powerscreen® Chieftain 2100X to split the product into aggregates. An older jaw crusher is sometimes used to pre crush the larger material before the Impactor.

After running like this for a while and with increased sales a Powerscreen® Maxtrak 1000 cone crusher was added to help increase the production rates. A Powerscreen® Warrior 1400 heavy duty screening plant with a 12' x 5' two deck screen was also purchased and is used to scalp out material or screen rubble when required.

Jason Clifford (Bernard's son) operates the crushing & screening plant and says "in regards to the backup, support and knowledge from the Lincom Group - it is very good and of a high standard. Their knowledge of the machines and the internal working parts is outstanding, their after sales support is impressive and they always answer their telephone calls or respond in a very short time frame."

Hallett Resources

Operating at McLaren Vale Quarry in South Australia, Hallett Resources Pty Ltd (part of the MSP Group) has recently commissioned a complete new Powerscreen® Crushing & Screening plant supplied by the Lincom Group.

The business had an opportunity to utilise the high grade material at McLaren Vale Quarry and to move in an industry specific direction that involved increased volumes of upper market, specified products (Asphalt, Sealing and Concrete Aggregates). Initial trials through their fixed plant based on volume, shape and these specific qualities for the required products indicated a need for a specific crushing plant to achieve the spread of these products.

Dick Sander (General Manager) says "knowing what we needed to accomplish from our material we reviewed available specifications on all mobile plant and took into consideration market responses from mobile applications around the country. We finalized the selection by trips to local operations and another state to view several operations in production mode and gained valuable information from the on-site managers controlling the plant."

"With the positive feed-back from market owners of similar plant and the reliable back-up support / knowledge / experience from their field operators (sales & service staff) of the Lincom Group we decided to go with the new Powerscreen® equipment" says Mathew Adam (Operations manager).

Originally an older jaw crusher, a VSI and a Powerscreen® screen were hired to work in with some equipment already owned by Hallett Resources, but it soon came clear that new plant with a higher capacity was required. This was when the new Powerscreen® equipment started arriving, a XR400S Jaw crusher with an 1100 x 700mm jaw, a H6203R with a 20' x 6' three deck horizontal screen box, a Maxtrak 1300 Cone crusher and a 16m conveyor. After running with this for a while the new Powerscreen® XV350 VSI and another H6203R screen arrived and were added to the circuit to replace older VSI and smaller screen.

"With the addition of the XV350 VSI and the second H6203R screen deck we are beginning to see the solution to the required volumes, clean aggregates and ability to handle seasonal demands. The flexibility and ease of adjustment of the XV350 VSI & Maxtrak 1300 Cone enable us to achieve the correct specification of the products easily" says Dick Sander.
