

The oldest working Powerscreen Competition – Terms and Conditions

1. Competition period

The competition opens on 21/09/2026 and closes on 01/12/2026. Entries received outside the competition period will not be accepted.

We may extend or vary the competition period where reasonably necessary. Any change will be announced through our website and social media channels.

2. Eligibility

Entry is open to PNG and Australian-registered businesses that own, or have the owner's written authority to enter, a Powerscreen machine.

The person submitting an entry on behalf of a business must be authorised to do so and must provide the business's correct legal or trading name.

Current employees of Lincom Group are not eligible to enter the competition.

Only genuine Powerscreen-branded machines are eligible.

The winning machine must be in working order at the time of judging and verification. A machine that cannot safely start, operate and perform its intended core function will not be eligible to win.

3. How to enter

Email marketing@lincom.com.au or send us a direct message on social media with the details of your machine and a recent photo or video.

Each entry must include:

- The entrant's full name, business name, phone number, email address and address
- The machine model, serial number, year of manufacture and current location
- At least three clear, recent photographs showing the complete machine, Powerscreen branding, serial number or serial number plate, and the machine at its current work site or storage location
- A recent video, preferably 20–60 seconds, showing the machine starting and operating safely
- A short account of the machine's history, work performed, maintenance and any major rebuilds or modifications

One entry is permitted per machine. An entrant may enter more than one machine, but each machine requires a separate entry.

If multiple people enter the same machine, we may accept the first valid entry, request evidence of ownership or authority, or ask the parties to nominate one authorised entrant.

Entries must be complete, accurate and submitted by the closing time.

4. Proof of ownership, age and working order

The entrant must be able to demonstrate that they own the machine or have the owner's express authority to enter it.

We will assess the machine's year of manufacture using the best reliable evidence available.

A model year, purchase year or date first used is not automatically the year of manufacture.

Working order means the machine can safely start, move where applicable, operate and perform its intended core crushing, screening, conveying or related function.

Cosmetic condition is not decisive. Normal wear, repairs, replacement parts, rebuilds and modifications may be accepted, provided the machine remains recognisably the entered Powerscreen machine and operates safely.

5. Judging

A panel will assess valid entries after the competition period closes.

The panel will consider the reliability and consistency of serial-number information, documentary evidence, photographs, videos, or manufacturer records.

If two or more eligible machines appear to be the same age and a clear manufacturing date cannot be established, the panel may consider serial-number sequence, continuity of machine identity and quality of verification. If the machines remain indistinguishable, the panel may award joint winners and divide the cash component equally, while providing a scale model to each joint winner.

6. Prize

The winner will receive a \$500 AUD VISA gift card and one Powerscreen Chieftain 1700X scale model.

The scale model is not redeemable for cash.

7. Winner notification and announcement

The confirmed winner will be announced on www.lincom.com.au and Lincom Group's social media channels.
